Career Information	During WW1 he was awarded the Military Cross on 1 January 1918 "For distinguished service in the field". He fought in Gallipoli, Egypt and the Western Front and was wounded at Messines in June 1917. He married Ada Helen WING, of 125 Castellain Mansions, Maid Vale, London at St Saviour's Church, Paddington on 17th December 1918
