George was a 92 year old retired engineer when he wrote this book. He also didn't go to theological college and his writings are not in ecclesiastical terms; they are in the words of the everyday reader and recount how he travelled through his spiritual life. He was ordained in Saxmundham Congregational Church in 1970 and he was brought up on a farm opposite Saxtead Mill.
