BRIGADIER WILLIAM ALBANY FETHERSTONHAUGH CB CBE DSO (1891-92)

The following is taken from the 1968 Register.

He was born on 24 October 1876 and went off to the Royal Military College at Sandhurst after leaving the College. Afterwards he joined he Indian Army and quickly rose through the ranks.

He served in the Punjab Frontier Campaign (1897-98), winning a medal and 2 clasps. In WW1 he was awarded the Distinguished Service Order on 1 January 1917 "For distinguished service in the field." He was also awarded the Legion d'Honneur and mentioned in dispatches 4 times.

He went on to serve in the Afghanistan and North West Frontier Campaign of 1919 and was awarded the CBE on 1 January 1920. Like **Brigadier General William Hugh Dobbie CB (1874-76)** he was appointed Assistant Quarter Master General for the Indian Army in 1922.

He was awarded a Companion of the Order of Bath (CB) in 1928 and retired from the Indian Army in 1929.
