

CAPTAIN HUGH VALENTINE SHERINGHAM (1899-1902)

Date of Birth	18 April 1886 in Thornage Norfolk. He was baptised in Thornage on 16 May 1886 and was the youngest child and only son of Henry and Edith Sheringham. The family lived in Thornage Hall where Henry was the tenant farmer of Lord Astley of nearby Melton Constable Hall. The tenancy passed to another family after Henry.
