

JOHN GORE HAZELWOOD CBE (R43-53)

He was born on 25 August 1934 and was a Pembroke Scholar at the College. On leaving he was commissioned into the Suffolk Regiment for National Service, where he served in Trieste and Germany. He spent seven years in the Territorial Army, mostly in East Anglia.

He joined Unilever as a Management Trainee following graduation in Natural Science at Downing College, Cambridge. He held a number of appointments in the UK mostly within the technical side of the company including Deputy Chairman of the Walls Ice Cream business in the UK, Managing Director of Embisco and Site General Manager of Walls Ice Cream Gloucester, the largest ice-cream factory in Europe.

He has held a number of ministerial appointments including the Merseyside Task Force, TEC National Council, Deputy Chairman of the Business Link Advisory Accreditation Board and Deputy Chairman of the Design Council. He continues to hold a ministerial appointment on the National Employers Advisory Board and is Chairman of the Wessex RFCA Employers Support Group.

He is currently Chairman of Gloucestershire Rural Community Council, Regional Chairman for Rural Community Councils in the South West and Treasurer of ACRE, the national Action Council for Rural England.

He is Chairman of the National Assessment Panel for Companions of the Chartered Management Institute and President of the Gloucestershire Branch of the Chartered Management Institute.

He has recently been elected Chairman of the Gloucestershire Development Agency and Warden of the Honourable Company of Gloucestershire.

He was appointed a CBE in 1994 for services to training and Deputy Lieutenant for Gloucestershire in 1994.
